- : Ir Raymond Wong has followed the HK-Zhuhai-Macau Bridge Project since the early days. He studied and collected a substantial amount of first-hand information in particular record images that covered all major details of work behind this project.
- In this seminar, Raymond will discuss from the perspective of construction frontline, the construction features of the project as a whole, which encompass the Hong Kong Link Road, carriageway network connecting the Link Road and the Man-made Island, the Hong Kong Port facilities, roadways connecting Tai Ho and Tuen Mun, as well as other related provisions which support the operation of the immigration/port facilities.

Raymond Wong, is an independent researcher and a lecturer in the Division of Building Science and Technology at City University of Hong Kong. He joined the construction profession in 1977 and he is currently a member of the HKIE and a retired member of the CIOB.</p> <p>Ir. Wong has conducted a series of studies in tall building construction, industrialized construction systems, urban studies, infrastructure projects and other related studies since 1995.</p> <p>In the recent 20 years, Ir. Wong has extended his study towards the urban development of some major cities of China, in particular Guangzhou, Shanghai, Beijing and Chongqing, with a focus on the urban planning, infrastructure development and revitalization projects in these cities.</p> <p>Ir Wong has produced more than 150 professional papers and publications in various media and journals. He has been invited frequently by a number of academic and professional institutions world-wide as an expert speaker to deliver talks on the above-mentioned topic areas.</p>
