Her firm is engaged in NEC contracts, having provided contract advisory services on over 12 cases of NEC contracts in recent years. She is a highly regarded Programming Expert in Hong Kong, with extensive experience in litigation, arbitration and mediation proceedings. She has participated in over 20 cases, with her expert evidence widely accepted by tribunals. She has established herself as a trusted authority in resolving complex construction disputes, particularly those involving project delays, disruption and acceleration claims.

Her expertise spans multiple sectors, including MTRC railway projects, gas stations, site formation and foundation, civil and infrastructure works, hotel developments, E&M works, and data centre projects. She has contributed to several major development projects in Macau such as City of Dreams and The Venetian; in Hong Kong including the projects of the Deep Bay Link North & South Sections, Route 8 Shatin Heights Tunnels & Approaches, West Rail, and MTR station design development; as well as Shenzhen Line 4 in China.
