Noise mitigation in the form of cantilever barriers, partial enclosure or full enclosure has long been considered as unpleasant visual impact to the environment. Time has changed as the recently built curved noise barriers at Tai Wo Road is an innovative architectural design to facelift Tai Wo Road adjacent to Po Nga Court. The project is seen as an icon in Tai Po District. This seminar will introduce the innovation design of the cantilever noise barriers at Tai Wo Road. Furthermore, the guest speakers will discuss how the noise barriers were effectively erected using the NEC (Option C) form of contract, and how the project team practised partnering spirit and collaborative working via NEC.
