Seminar Highlights

The New Engineering Contract Version 3 (NEC3) is a family of contracts that facilitate the implementation of sound project management principles and practices based on a spirit of mutual trust and co-operation. This seminar will describe the development and application of NEC contracts in Hong Kong, including the key features of NEC contracts, highlights of research findings on benefits, difficulties and success factors for NEC contracts, case studies on some NEC completed projects in Hong Kong and the United Kingdom for illustration, and the future development trend of NEC contracts.

Guest Speaker

Dr Daniel W.M. Chan, *BEng(Hons), PhD, MAPM, MHKICM, MASCE, MHKIPM, MAIPM*, is an Associate Professor in Construction Project Management and the Programme Leader for "MSc/PgD in Construction and Real Estate" at the Department of Building and Real Estate of The Hong Kong Polytechnic University. He is a project manager and construction manager by profession. His current research interests include construction time performance, construction procurement systems, relational and collaborative contracting, partnering and alliancing, target cost contracting, New Engineering Contract (NEC), public-private partnership, and construction safety management. He has published over 180 research papers on the broad theme of project management in leading construction management journals and international conference proceedings. He is currently a Council Member of the Hong Kong Institute of Project Management (HKIPM) and the Chairman of CPD Committee.
